A Note From Our Nurse...

Here at Precious Memories Preschool of Sandy Hollow, our goal for all our little friends is to have happy and healthy days. It is a reality that sometimes children become ill and need to be sent home from school for a variety of health-related reasons. Our school has developed effective policies specifically related to sickness and appropriateness for the return to school. We ask that children not return for 24 hours in cases of fever of 100.4 or greater, vomiting or two cases of diarrhea. Children may return to school after this 24-hour period and symptom free (WITHOUT using fever reducing medications). We want your children to feel well enough to take part in school activities and it is important to minimize potential contagion exposure to other children as well. We appreciate all of you for working with us to provide as healthy an environment as possible. --Rebecca Stilphen, RN
